

BPEC Water Regulations & Byelaws (Part-Time)

This course is designed to familiarise delegates with the contents of the Water Regulations and Byelaws across the UK. It meets the requirements of Water Regs UK on behalf of the water undertakers which participate in the Water Industry Approved Plumbers' Scheme (WIAPS).

Entry Requirements

Delegates will need to have some knowledge of plumbing and the water industry. In addition, previous knowledge of hot and cold-water systems is expected.

Career Prospects

Successful delegates are encouraged to join an approved plumbers'/contractors' scheme, such as those managed by SNIPEF, APHC, CIPHE, WIAPS, and the regional water utility companies. This enables delegates to issue a certificate of completion to both the householder and water company.
