

Level 3 Installation and Maintenance of Automatic Fire Sprinkler Systems (Part-Time)

This course is for individuals who hold a Water Regulations qualification and wish to gain the necessary knowledge to install and maintain domestic fire sprinkler systems.

This route is suitable for those already working within the sprinkler industry and those who wish to upskill, change profession or for companies wishing to undertake CPD with their installers.

Entry Requirements

Cold Water Regulations certificate and/or a Level 3 plumbing qualification.

- Be able to install and commission an automatic fire sprinkler system
- Carry out service and maintenance checks of a domestic dwelling fire sprinkler system
- System requirements
- Legislation
- BS9251 the main British Standard covering fire sprinklers in the country
- The different types of fire sprinkler heads and water connections
